(ORLANDO)—StoicDan, the organizer of Orlando Stoics, is collaborating with several networks in Central Florida, including the Faith Care Network, sponsored by Advent Health. They are offering a program meeting in Sanford on April 17 titled "A Conversation on Homelessness."

The discussion will center around the state of homelessness in our area, the resources that are available through the network, and how to prevent homelessness.

"In the Stoic tradition, we learn the importance of accepting things beyond our control. Homelessness might be caused by numerous factors beyond our control, so an awareness of this helps to maintain inner peace and tranquility," said StoicDan. "However, Stoicism also recognizes the importance of reason in handling difficulties in our lives. Embracing reason in a modern sense can mean finding those resources you may not have considered before."

Advent Health is assembling a network of services that can help people through homelessness services include government organizations that help with rent, food pantries that provide food, and other services like free dental work.

Locating these services independently would involve much labor, but using the Faith Care Network, they are all collected under one virtual roof, including contact information for each provider.

According to the meeting page, the organizers plan to cover:

- State of Homelessness: Get the facts and stats about homelessness in Seminole County.
- Resources for Assistance: Learn about the range of resources available to support those experiencing homelessness.
- Preventing Homelessness: Discover practical strategies to prevent homelessness in our community.
